1.0 Scope of Policy/Procedure

• The intent of this policy is to promote equity, democracy and integrity in the decisions of North Bay Regional Health Centre, by providing guidance on voting procedures to ensure that Administrative Bylaws are observed.

2.0 Policy Statement

- A majority of the voting Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
- Business arising at any meeting of the Board shall be decided by a majority of votes of the Board.
- A declaration by the Chair that a resolution has been carried and an entry to that effect in the minutes is
 conclusive evidence of the fact without proof of the number or proportion of votes recorded in favour of or against
 the resolution.

3.0 Procedure/Process

- 3.1 In Person Meetings
 - Votes shall be taken by a show of hands or, if so demanded by any voting Director, votes shall be taken by
 written secret ballot. The Chair shall have a vote and, if there is an equality of votes, the motion is lost.

3.2 Electronic Meetings

(a) If all Directors consent thereto generally or in respect of a particular meeting and each has adequate access, such persons may participate in a meeting of the Board by means of such conference telephone or other **Disclaimer:** This is a controlled document for internal use only.

Policy/Procedure documents appearing on paper are not controlled should always be checked against the electronic version prior to use.

- communications facilities as permit all persons participating in the meeting to hear each other, and a person participating in such a meeting by such means is deemed to be present at the meeting.
- (b) Provided that at the outset of each such meeting, and whenever votes are required, the Chair of the meeting shall call roll to establish quorum, and shall, whenever not satisfied that the proceedings of the meeting may proceed with adequate security and confidentiality, unless a majority of the persons present at such meeting otherwise require, adjourn the meeting to a predetermined date, time and place.

3.3 Policy Oversight

 It is the responsibility of each Director to be aware of policies and to raise points of order within meetings with regard to questions of policy adherence. The Governance Committee is responsible for periodically reviewing and monitoring this policy.
