Job Description

The North Bay Regional Health Centre has a unique practice opportunity for a Psychiatrist to provide psychiatric care to patients of its Service of Specialized Rehabilitation Psychiatry.

The Service of Specialized Rehabilitation Psychiatry includes 40 specialized rehabilitation beds across two sites (with a total average of 50 admissions annually) serving those with severe and persistent mental illness and co-morbid conditions. All units provide short-term inpatient assessment, treatment and rehabilitation, and transitional support to return "home". Using a patient centered, interdisciplinary approach to care, services are delivered to promote the active participation of individuals in their own recovery. Psychiatrists with this program also provide outpatient services via various outpatient clinics as part of a team.

The successful candidate will be expected to participate in the Department of Psychiatry hospital on-call rota, provide ECT services to inpatients and outpatients and consult liaison services to the medical units of the organization. There are opportunities to expand practice interests by providing advice and guidance to mental health partners across the region utilizing virtual support to remote and rural areas through our telemedicine service. The organization is an affiliated academic teaching centre with the Northern Ontario School of Medicine (NOSM). The preferred candidate will be expected to participate in teaching undergraduate and postgraduate medical learners.

North Bay Regional Health Centre is a unique 419 bed health care organization with three primary roles: providing acute care services to North Bay and its surrounding communities, functioning as the district referral center providing specialist services for smaller communities in the area, and it's the specialized mental health service provider serving all of northeast Ontario. Qualifications

Applicants are required to be certified in Psychiatry by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (or the equivalent in another jurisdiction) and must be licensed (or eligible for licensure) in the Province of Ontario.
