Job Summary

NBRHC is a large community hospital with a dynamic service of Internal Medicine. Our complement of 9 members presently includes general internists, nephrologists, gastroenterologists, endocrinologists and a respirologist. All members of the service share in the Internal Medicine on-call rota responsibilities including providing consultative services for hospital ER and in-patients as well as working in our sixteen bed ICU in collaboration with our anaesthesia colleagues. Our on-call model is supported by physician assistants to allow you to spend more time at the bedside, and less time on the computer. The organization is an affiliated academic teaching centre with the Northern Ontario School of Medicine (NOSM) and our service is involved in teaching the undergraduate medical and postgraduate Family Medicine and Internal Medicine residents.

Qualifications

Applicants are required to be certified in Internal Medicine by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and licensed (or eligible for licensure) in the Province of Ontario.

North Bay Regional Health Centre is a 419 bed health care organization with three primary roles: providing acute care services to North Bay and its surrounding communities, functioning as the district referral center providing specialist services for smaller communities in the area, and it is the specialized mental health service provider serving all of northeast Ontario.
