Job Description

The Service of Ophthalmology of the North Bay Regional Health Centre is actively recruiting an Ophthalmologist to join its collegial team. NBRHC is a large community hospital that hosts a self-contained Ophthalmology unit that allows for patients to register, receive surgery and be discharged in an efficient timeframe. NBRHC Ophthalmologists provide general adult and paediatric eye care. The successful candidate will have weekly available resources including full day cataract OR, full day minor OR, and access to glaucoma and retinal lasers. They will participate in the on-call roster, 1:3.

Opportunity is available to take over an established practice in the community should the candidate desire.

Applicants are required to be certified by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and must be licensed (or eligible for licensure) in the Province of Ontario. The organization is an affiliated academic teaching centre with the Northern Ontario School of Medicine (NOSM). The preferred candidate would be expected to participate in teaching undergraduates and postgraduate medical learners.

North Bay Regional Health Centre is a unique 419 bed health care organization with three primary roles: providing acute care services to North Bay and its surrounding communities, functioning as the district referral center providing specialist services for smaller communities in the area, and it's the specialized mental health service provider serving all of northeast Ontario.
