The North Bay Regional Health Department of Psychiatry is seeking a Community Based General Psychiatrist.

Job Description

The North Bay Regional Health Centre has a unique practice opportunity for a Community Based Permanent Full-Time General Psychiatrist to provide psychiatric care to patients of its Assertive Community Treatment Team and Outpatient Mental Health Clinic.

The Assertive Community Treatment Team (ACTT) provides community based client centered, recovery oriented mental health services for persons with serious mental illness residing in the community. Services are delivered by an interdisciplinary mental health team that includes a team psychiatrist. The team provides the majority of the treatment, rehabilitation and support services that clients need to achieve their goals and maintain their wellness. Intensive services are provided based on individual needs and mutually agreed upon plan between the client and ACTT staff.

The Outpatient Mental Health Clinic is a community-based program which provides focused treatment, education and support services to individuals who have been diagnosed with a moderate to severe and persistent mental illness. Using a patient centered, interdisciplinary and collaborative approach to care, the service promotes the active participation of individuals in their own recovery. Services are provided by a professionally trained and qualified multi-disciplinary team which includes psychiatrists, registered nurses, family physicians, social workers and a psychologist. A wide array of services is offered to patients with the intent to assist them in achieving their goals, improving their overall level of functioning and thereby enhancing their level of satisfaction and quality of life.

There are opportunities to expand practice interests by providing advice and guidance to mental health partners across the region utilizing virtual support to remote and rural areas through our telemedicine service.

The successful candidate will be expected to participate in the Department of Psychiatry hospital on-call rota, provide ECT services to inpatients and outpatients and consult liaison services to the inpatient medical units of the hospital.

Qualifications

Applicants are required to be certified in Psychiatry by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (or the equivalent in another jurisdiction) and must be licensed (or eligible for licensure) in the Province of Ontario.

North Bay Regional Health Centre is a unique health care organization with three primary roles: providing acute care services to North Bay and its surrounding communities, functioning as the district referral center providing specialist services for smaller communities in the area, and it's the specialized mental health service provider serving all of northeast Ontario.
