

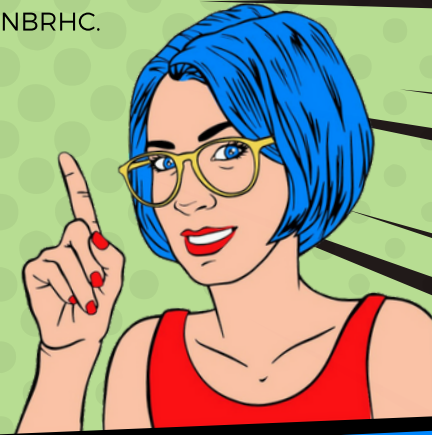


# Virtual L.E.A.D. Program
