Affiliated with North Bay Regional Health Centre, Family Physicians in North Bay have competitive earning opportunities, are members of progressive and collegial teams, and practice inpatient medicine at NBRHC, a state-of-the-art community hospital.

A family medicine general practice with 1400 rostered patients in North Bay, Ontario is available to take over at your convenience. The current MD is very flexible, willing to help in transition and will offer part-time help / locum coverage.

The practice is part of a local Family Health Organization that provides comprehensive family medicine including hospital inpatient care with relatively light on-call hospital responsibilities. We have excellent office staff who are available to stay on for transition, if desired.

This position offers participation as a member of the NBRHC Department of General & Family Practice - an efficient and collegial department that is actively engaged in our community and plays an important role with hospital care. Members provide hospital inpatient care to their rostered patients and share in the care of admitted orphan patients.

Applicants are required to be certified by the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC), and be licensed or eligible for licensure through the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO).

Family Physicians in North Bay have the opportunity for Faculty Appointment with the Northern Ontario School of Medicine (NOSM), allowing for the teaching of undergraduate and postgraduate medical learners.
