

At the time, it was deemed that there were no other regional providers able to meet the service requirements.	NBRHC will undertake an open competitive procurement for this service in 2024.
Protective Services (Security)	Securiguard Services	\$119,000	This contract was established through a Supply Ontario Vendor of Record. Due to unforeseen circumstances, Supply Ontario chose not to exercise the contract extension option, very late in the initial term. As such, NBRHC extended the existing contract until Supply Ontario has established the VOR arrangement.	Supply Ontario now has a VOR arrangement established.
