The General Applications Analyst will assume primary responsibility for analysing, interpreting and identifying trends within Meditech Expanse in addition to supporting scheduling and patient registration modules. Reporting to the Manager of Clinical Informatics & Information Systems, responsibilities of this position include but will not be limited to:

- Participate and assist in the design, development, testing, implementation, maintenance and evaluation of applications, tools, processes, and structures of the scheduling and patient registration modules.
- Responsible for day-to-day end user support and providing proper assignment of access.
- Provides on-going support of current applications including troubleshooting errors, logging issues, and implementing system upgrades.
- Assesses end user needs and assists in developing proposals and solutions for those needs by engaging key stakeholders.
- Develop education plans, facilitate training and support of clinical users, and designs/maintains training tools and users manuals; understands and applies the principles of adult education while providing training to stakeholder.
- Proactively seek operational improvements within the EMR by performing audits, data and analysis of findings to identify areas for quality improvement and efficiency as it relates to the health information systems.
