POSITION SUMMARY

Energetic and motivated individual needed to work as a Physician Assistant with a dynamic and collegial team. Reporting to the Medical Director/Manager of Emergency Medicine, the Physician Assistant will work in collaboration with emergency medicine physicians in accordance with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario's policy on delegation and under Medical Directives.

The Physician Assistant will be involved in collecting and interpreting current, historical and diagnostic information about the patient for the purpose of establishing a diagnosis and treatment plan. The Physician Assistant will have the opportunity to work with a diverse patient population. As part of the interprofessional team, quality improvement will be part of the PA's role and he/she will have an opportunity to research and perform administrative responsibilities. Responsibilities will also include coordinating and participating in policy and procedure development as well as education and professional development. They will act as a resource and consultant to individuals and groups within our professional community and other agencies and hospitals.

The Physician Assistant will be supported with a comprehensive onboarding program and competency-based training led by the Emergency Medicine Medical Director. Both on-the-job training for delegated procedures with supervising physician and opportunities to complete formal CME education in areas like casting and suturing will be supported.
