

Volunteer Opportunities

Ambassador Program

Volunteers welcome patients and visitors when they enter the Health Centre and provide general assistance, directions and way-finding support. Volunteers are encouraged to escort people to their destinations, or may choose to remain seated at the entrance if preferred.

- Volunteer shifts available on weekdays, evenings and weekends.

Clinic Support

Volunteers support the registration process in outpatient clinics to help improve patient flow, minimize stress and promote a positive patient experience.

- Volunteer shifts available on weekdays only.

Inpatient Unit Support

Volunteers support patients during their time in hospital by providing companionship through friendly visiting and assisting with recreation therapy group activities.

- Volunteer shifts available on weekdays, evenings and weekends.
- If you play a musical instrument or love to sing, you can use your skills to bring added joy and enrichment to the patient experience.

Hospital Elder Life Program (HELP)

HELP is an innovative approach to improving hospital care for patients aged 70 and over. This evidence-based program aims to promote recovery and assist with the transition from hospital to home by supporting the physical, cognitive and emotional well-being of older patients.

- Volunteer shifts available on weekdays, evenings and weekends.
- Volunteers receive specialized training in seniors care, as well as ongoing coaching and support from the Elder Life Specialist.



Pet Therapy

Volunteer therapy animals bring comfort, joy and companionship to members of our hospital community through regular visitation and therapeutic activities. Recruitment for the program happens on an as-needed basis due to the high level of interest. We keep applications on file and reach out if opportunities become available.

Gift Shop

Volunteers help raise funds for the NBRHC Foundation by providing courteous and efficient service to customers visiting the Gift Shop at the Health Centre. Funds raised support patient programming and the purchase of medical equipment.

Nevada Tickets

Volunteers help raise funds for the NBRHC Foundation by selling break-open Nevada Tickets at the Health Centre. Funds raised support patient programming and the purchase of medical equipment.
